

Telehealth funding opportunities

- Telehealth Network Grant Program provided by the US Dept of Health and Human Services, Application Due May 1st
 - This grant is designed to demonstrate how telehealth networks are used to (a) expand access to, coordinate, improve health care quality; (b) expand training of health care providers; (c) expand quality of health information available to health care providers, patients and families
 - The grant has 8.7 million dollars total with each award maxing out at \$300,000. There is no cost sharing and indirect costs cap at 15%
 - Funding is aimed at telehealth services with a focus on tele-emergency, tele-stroke, tele-behavioral and tele-EMS
 - Eligible entities are rural and urban that provide direct clinical services through a telehealth network. Must be a non-profit designation.
 - This grant must be submitted by individual entities once they have registered with SAM.gov and Grants.gov.
- Distance Learning and Telemedicine Grant provided by the US Dept of Agriculture and USDA Rural Development, Application April 10th and Second Window July 13
 - This grant is for the acquisition of eligible capital assets including (a) broadband transmission equipment; (b) audio, video or interactive video equipment; (c) terminal and data terminal equipment; (d) computer hardware, network components and software; (e) inside wiring and similar infrastructure that further DLT services; (f) acquisition of instructional programming that is a capital asset; (g) acquisition of technical assistance and instruction for using eligible equipment
 - The grant is designed to assist rural areas receive care that would not otherwise be available to them. Scoring of the grant application considers the rural area, the financial indicator of the area being served and has a special opioid component to it.
 - Eligible entities can be rural and urban provided the services they are providing for are all rural in nature.
 - Grant awards range from \$50,000 to \$1,000,000 with a 15% match in costs required by the facility.

- This grant is eligible for informal consortium filing for multiple entities once the applying entity has registered with SAM.gov and Grants.gov
- COVID Telehealth Grant provided by the Federal Communications Commission,
Application Deadline not yet out.
 - This is a new grant that is being proposed to support a health care provider's use of telehealth services to combat the COVID-19 pandemic. The grant would eligible providers to purchase telehealth hardware and equipment.
 - Details of this grant have not been made available yet.
