Emergency Department Evaluation and Management of Patients Under Investigation for COVID-19 (2019 Novel Coronavirus) Infection

Identify exposure history:

In the 14 days before symptom onset, patient traveled from a COVID-19 affected geographic area* or had close contact with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 (novel coronavirus).

NO

Continue with usual triage.

YES

Identify signs and symptoms:

Fever (subjective or > 100.4 F or 38.0 C) or symptoms of lower respiratory illness, such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.



Continue with usual triage. HCP follow droplet standard precautions.

YES

Isolate and Prevent Transmission:

- Place mask on patient.
- Escort patient to exam room (negative pressure if available) immediately and close the door.
- Healthcare Personnel (HCP) entering the exam room must wear a gown, gloves, eye
 protection (goggles or face shield), a N-95 mask or PAPR (if no shortage) or a regular
 face mask if N95 in short supply.
- Only essential HCP and Clinician should evaluate the patient.
