### HHS extends deadline for attestation, acceptance of terms and conditions

The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has [extended the deadline](#) for health care providers to attest to receipt of payments from the Public Health and Social Services Emergency Fund and accept the [terms and conditions](#).

Providers now will have 90 days, increased from 45 days, from the date they receive a payment to attest and accept the terms and conditions or return the funds. With the extension, not returning the payment within 90 days of receipt of payment will be viewed as acceptance of the terms and conditions.

### Iowa DHS launches free virtual counseling sessions for Iowans

The Iowa Department of Human Services (DHS) has received nearly \$1 million in funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency to offer free counseling to any Iowan who has been affected by the COVID-19 public health emergency. The [COVID Recovery Iowa](#) program is available starting today. Counseling takes place by virtual sessions, chat or telephone call. People of all ages may join groups online to find support and learn new strategies to cope with the effects of the pandemic in a variety of ways. DHS has contracted with five providers throughout the state for counseling, virtual activities, referrals and help finding resources. COVID Recovery Iowa will announce additional programs in the coming weeks to help Iowans build coping skills and resilience. For more information, visit the [COVID Recovery website](#).

### State provides cloth masks for Hy-Vee and Fareway to distribute for free

The Iowa Department of Public Health provided 75,000 cloth masks to Hy-Vee to distribute to customers at more than 125 of their Iowa grocery stores and drugstores, and 35,000 cloth masks to Fareway for distribution through 108 of their stores. Cloth masks will be available for free at each store on a first-come, first-served basis. Masks were donated in partnership with HanesBrands, the US Department of Health and Human Services and the Centers for Disease Control.
