Iowa hospital workforce survey finds ongoing needs in many areas

Last fall, the Iowa Hospital Association surveyed member hospitals about their workforce needs since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic. Nearly three quarters of Iowa's hospitals completed the survey.

The survey results show that Iowa hospitals have an overwhelming need for positions that tend to be difficult to hire, especially registered nurses, laboratory technicians, certified nursing assistants, emergency medical services personal and environmental services employees. To help attract and retain employees, hospitals are using incentives such as loan reimbursement, flexible scheduling, sign-on bonuses and governmental programs.

IHA will use the results of the hospital workforce survey to build education and programming around hospital needs. IHA also will review the data and needs of hospitals after the legislative session to determine if legislation can be advanced to help hospitals with these workforce needs.

Study looks at general surgery in rural US

According to [a recent study by the Rural Health Research Gateway](#), between 2001 and 2019, the per capita supply of general surgeons in the US decreased 18% overall and 29.1% in rural areas. The study also found that rural general surgeons are older than their urban counterparts. In 2019, 59.4% of the general surgeons in rural areas were 50 or older. compared to 48.8% in urban areas.

The study concludes that long-term preservation of rural surgical services will require concerted efforts by medical school educators, residency directors and rural advocates to promote and sustain interest in rural general surgery among medical students and surgical residents, especially women.
