IHA Board Governance Committee to meet next week

The Iowa Hospital Association Governance Committee will meet **Tuesday, June 15**, to discuss candidates for the IHA Board of Officers and Trustees. Committee members are:

IHA members are encouraged to suggest people for consideration by the Governance Committee for positions on the board. The committee will evaluate candidates on:

- Ability and willingness to be a strong and active leader on the board.
- Participation as a grassroots advocate and in IHA meetings and events.
- Personal attributes and experience that demonstrate an ability to make positive contributions to the association.

The committee also will consider gender balance and diversity, and a balance of representation based on IHA districts, hospital size and hospital ownership. Anyone wishing to make a recommendation is encouraged to forward the suggestion to any of the listed committee members or to IHA President and CEO Kirk Norris.

The Governance Committee will report its recommendations to the IHA Board of Officers and Trustees in August. If approved, the recommendations will be voted on by the IHA House of Delegates in October when the delegates meet during the IHA Annual Meeting.

IHA releases latest hospital data trends

IHA has collected [Iowa hospital data trends for January-April 2021](#) as compared with the same time frame in 2020. 105 Iowa hospitals are included in this report:

- Acute discharges decreased 2.4% as acute patient days increased 4%.
- Average length of stay increased 6.7%.
- Births decreased 4%.
- Charity care increased 4%.
- Emergency department visits decreased 5.5%.
- Facility employment (excluding physicians) stayed the same.
- Hospital-based ambulatory surgery visits increased 32.3%.
- Inpatient admissions from the emergency department increased 1.1%.
- Inpatient surgeries increased 10.1%.
- Medicaid acute discharges increased 0.1%, and Medicaid acute patient days increased 7.6%.
- Net patient revenue (collected charges) increased 18.7%.
- Outpatient utilization increased 18.4%.
- Total expenses increased 8.2%.
- Uncompensated care (bad debts) decreased 16.8%.
