**(IHA PAC) was established in 1990 to
unite hospital and health system leaders
to maximize their political visibility.**

What is a PAC, and how does it work?

PACs promote their sponsoring organizations' views and positions through involvement in the political and electoral process by supporting the campaigns of specific elected officials and candidates. The IHA PAC is not affiliated with any candidate or political party and participates in elections for the Iowa House and Senate only. The IHA PAC supports candidates for state office whose philosophies, actions, positions and voting records reflect an understanding and concern for Iowa hospitals, health systems and health care issues.

About 80% of contributions to the IHA PAC remain in Iowa and a portion of the IHA PAC contributions support candidates for federal political offices through the American Hospital Association Political Action Committee.

Most IHA PAC contributions are from hospital executives and other hospitals leaders with management responsibilities, including eligible directors and supervisors with IHA personal membership groups.

How does the IHA PAC help?

The IHA PAC is a critical facet of the association's advocacy program. Hospital and health systems enjoy a level of political visibility that would not exist otherwise. The IHA PAC sends a powerful message of unity on behalf of Iowa hospitals to legislators, congressional leaders, committee chairs, political party leaders and the entire state political structure.
