REH issues, board nominees and DEI pledge discussed by IHA board

The potential conversion of hospitals to rural emergency hospitals (REH) was among the topics discussed at the IHA board meeting, Wednesday, Aug. 11, during a retreat of the IHA, ServiShare and IHERF boards. IHA continues to work with its member workgroup and AHA on regulatory strategy and response to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' requests for information about REH implementation. Also discussed at the meeting was a [study](#) released in July by the North Carolina Rural Health Research Program that estimates possible hospital conversions to REH nationwide.

The board unanimously approved the IHA Governance Committee recommendations for IHA's 2021/2022 board nominees and leadership positions. Among other board matters was the approval of a diversity, equity and inclusion pledge submitted by the IHA Committee on Diversity, Health Equity and Inclusion. IHA member hospitals will be encouraged to adopt and approve [the pledge](#). A formal launch is planned in conjunction with the DEI sessions at the IHA Annual Meeting

AHA Region 6 Executive Elizabeth Summy provided an AHA board update followed by state and federal legislative updates. Reports also were received from the ServiShare and IHERF boards. Two new IHA associate members, [Claim Capital](#) and [Fire Door Solutions](#), were approved.

The next meeting of the IHA Board is Monday, Oct. 4, during the IHA Annual Meeting.

Some hospitals report frustrations with mandatory reporter training

IHA has been made aware that some hospitals have experienced significant frustrations with the Mandatory Reporter Training system, some reporting that the two-hour training is taking as long as four- to five-hours to complete. IHA has been in communication with the Iowa Department of

Human Services, which hosts the online training, and Iowa State University, which maintains the training system, to resolve the issues. Please report any additional barriers to completing this training or questions to [Jennifer Nutt](#) or [Erin Cubit](#) at IHA.

Guardian Insurance voluntary plans offer college tuition reimbursement

Hospital employees participating in the Guardian Insurance Voluntary Employee Benefit program sponsored by ServiShare are eligible to participate in the College Tuition Reimbursement plan.

Employees enrolled in a Guardian plan can earn \$2,000 per plan in annual Tuition Rewards. Participating schools have entered into a contractual agreement to reduce their tuition by the amount of Tuition Rewards submitted by the member. Tuition Rewards are a guaranteed minimum discount off the full "list price" of tuition as opposed to monetary reimbursement. One Tuition Reward point is the same as \$1 reduction in full tuition.

Members can register students who are part of their immediate or extended family, including children, grandchildren, nieces, nephews, stepchildren and godchildren. Eligible students must be enrolled in the program no later than Tuesday, Aug. 24, of their junior year of high school. Rewards stop accruing on Aug. 24 of the eligible student's senior year of high school. Tuition Rewards cannot be used by an employee for their own or a partner's education, or if a child has already started 12th grade.

Tuition Rewards are capped at a maximum 25% discount, divided evenly over four years. Rewards may be combined with financial aid.
