IHA submits feedback about Iowa Medicaid's state plan amendment for rebasing

On Monday, [IHA submitted comments](#) to the Department of Human Services about Iowa Medicaid's State Plan Amendment regarding inpatient hospital reimbursement rates. The comments focused on concerns about the timeline for when updated reimbursement rates become active and the administrative burden the delay causes when providers resubmit claims. IHA also noted for DHS that Medicaid reimbursement rates have not had an inflationary increase since July 2013.

The Crises in Nursing and Pandemic Care webinar registration open

The COVID-19 pandemic has exposed a crisis in nursing as staff shortages and worker burnout take its toll. The [Can't Pour From an Empty Cup: The Crises in Nursing and Pandemic Care webinar](#) will address challenges facing nurses during the pandemic and how this trauma plays a role in professional and workforce conditions. The webinar is scheduled from 1-2 pm, Thursday, Nov. 30.

Candace Burton, PhD, associate professor in the Sue and Bill Gross School of Nursing at the University of California will:

- Describe the elements of an appropriately trauma-informed work environment during the pandemic.
- Identify sources of trauma affecting nurses during the pandemic.
- Review how trauma and burnout intersect to reduce nurses' capacity to provide safe, effective, nonjudgmental care.

Moderna updates expiration date extensions for COVID-19 vaccines

The Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) released information about expiration date extensions for the Moderna COVID-19 vaccines. A total of 78 lots have been approved for extensions.

Challenges with IT systems have slowed updates of the extensions. IDPH recommendations hospitals, health systems and providers continue to use Moderna's look up tool as the official indicator of produce expiry. Visit the look up tool [HERE](#).
