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### IHA advocacy team weekly roundup

This week, the IHA advocacy team met with Senate President Jake Chapman (R-Adel), Senate Majority Leader Jack Whitver (R-Ankeny), House Majority Leader Matt Windschitl (R-Missouri Valley) and House Minority Leader Jennifer Konfrst (D-Windsor Heights) to introduce Chris Mitchell, IHA's new president and CEO, to Senate and House leadership and to give an in-depth overview of [IHA's 2022 legislative priorities](#). The conversations centered on:

- Hospital workforce priorities including ideas to recruit and retain health care workers, such as tax incentives and grants for students as they are in school, as well as tort reform.
- Hospital financial priorities including telehealth payment parity for physical health services, increasing the cost adjustment factor for critical access hospitals, instituting a Medicaid rate for administrative days or days awaiting placement, and easing complexities within the Medicaid program.
- Adding licensure for rural emergency hospitals in the Iowa Code.

IHA's advocacy team also virtually attended the Health Insurance Mandate Review Committee Wednesday. The passage of [HF 838](#) created this committee that was tasked with discussing mandates, the number of lowans covered by each type of insurance and the method for determining, collecting and submitting the fiscal impact of each mandate. There are no providers on the committee, but the committee discussed including a health care provider before the next meeting Wednesday, Dec. 8.

IHA's advocacy team is exploring how IHA can best be a resource for this committee moving forward as they work to bring recommendations to the Iowa Legislature before the 2022 session.

### Federal vaccine requirement

Thursday, IHA's advocacy team released information through a special edition of IHA Today about CMS' emergency rule-making requiring entities that participate in the Medicare and Medicaid programs to develop and implement policies for staff COVID-19 vaccinations. Facilities covered by this regulation, including Iowa

hospitals, must have a policy in place that ensures eligible staff have received the first of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine or a one-dose COVID-19 vaccine by Sunday, Dec. 5, 2021, and have their second dose of a two-dose vaccine by Tuesday, Jan. 4, 2022. OSHA also released a new emergency temporary standard to protect workers from COVID-19. The standard applies to employers with 100 or more employees, but facilities that participate in the Medicare and Medicaid programs are expected to abide by the requirements established by CMS because that rule takes priority over other federal vaccination requirements.

IHA is analyzing both sets of guidance as well as the state legislation signed into law last week to assess the impact on Iowa hospitals and will provide additional information in the coming days.

### **CMS offers webinar about PAMA clinical laboratory data reporting**

CMS is hosting a webinar about the Medicare Clinical Laboratory Fee Schedule Private Payor Data Collection and Reporting ([private payor data collection and reporting policies](#)) from **2:30-3:30 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 10.**

The PAMA requirement to report private payor data soon will apply to many hospitals with outreach laboratories, which will be required to report their private payor laboratory prices and volumes. Specifically, hospitals that received at least \$12,500 in Medicare revenues from Clinical Laboratory Fee Schedule services billed on the CMS 1450 14X bill type from Jan. 1 through June 30, 2019, will be required to report on this data between January and March 2022.
