IHERF receives Broadlawns donation

The [Broadlawns Medical Center](#) Guild donated more than \$31,000 to IHA's Iowa Hospital and Education Research Foundation Health Care Careers Scholarship Program last week.

"We are grateful for this generous donation from Broadlawns," said IHA Executive Vice President Perry Meyer. "With the support of our member hospitals and hospital leaders, IHERF supports more students interested in health care and ensures Iowa's hospitals have a strong workforce for years to come."

IHA established the IHERF Health Care Careers Scholarship Program in 2004 to help address the shortage of health care professionals and encourage young Iowans to establish or continue their careers with Iowa hospitals. The first scholarships were awarded in 2005; now, more than 685 students have benefited from the program.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' Kansas City office will hold its Rural Health Week from June 13-17 featuring sessions for rural health care providers in the Midwest including Iowa.

Sessions are from noon-1 p.m. and will feature a brief presentation followed by listening sessions. Providers can ask questions or let CMS know about challenges, good news or what's on a facility's wish list.
