IHA hires Robb Gardner as chief of staff

IHA President and CEO Chris Mitchell announced IHA has hired former Henry County Health Center CEO Robb Gardner. Gardner will join the IHA leadership team as chief of staff. Gardner's new role will encompass many areas, but his focus will be member outreach.

"Robb is a proven champion and effective advocate for health care and IHA," Mitchell said. "His past experience as a hospital leader and involvement with IHA will bring a unique insight into our path forward as an organization."

Gardner previously was IHA Board treasurer on the IHA Board Executive Committee and was chair of the IHA Council of Health Information. He also received IHA's 2021 Excellence in Leadership Award. He will begin his role at IHA Monday, Aug. 29.

IHA advocacy team weekly roundup

The IHA advocacy team continues getting member input on IHA's 2023 legislative priorities. The workforce work group met for the first time Thursday with members identifying legislative issues and other challenges including violence against health care staff.

The IHA Health System Advisory Group met reviewing matters from earlier work group meetings and had productive conversations about IHA's legislative priorities including Medicaid reimbursement, pharmacy issues and certificate of need.

The advocacy team met with the Governor's office this week discussing opportunities for Iowa hospitals to access and use American Rescue Plan Act funding. Earlier in the week, they also met with Senate Minority Leader Zach Wahls discussing likely 2023 legislative priorities.

HeartCorp offers opportunity to impact rural health

The American Heart Association has partnered with the Public Health AmeriCorps program to create HeartCorps. HeartCorps is providing career pathways to new public health employees while meeting the public health needs of local health organizations.

The new service is looking for two to four host sites in Iowa, including rural hospitals,

whose efforts to improve patients and community health would benefit from hosting a member for 10-11 months. HeartCorps members will help people improve and control their blood pressure and promote cardiovascular health.

HeartCorps will place members at no cost at sites and will cover living allowance, health insurance and educational expenses. Sites will receive a \$10,000 capacity-building stipend to purchase additional clinic or home-based blood pressure monitors. In exchange, host sites should be willing to:

- Provide a physical space for the member to work.
- Provide day-to-day supervision.
- Work with the American Heart Association and members to develop work plans.
- Work with the American Heart Association to recruit local candidates.
