1. You are not alone-Cultivate Partnerships in your community, hospitals, state organizations
 2. Lean on Staff for recruitment

 5. Make a list of what vols do and share with the staff

Sharon Scott-

1. Delegate tasks, Have an openness with viewpoints
2. Understand your own energy level (Understand your limitations)
3. Really listen. Most people hear, but don't listen
4. Scout out potential Leaders—Has a little “black book” - Notice people who raise hand, sit in front row, etc. little clues as to potential leaders
5. Ask people to “take a chance on themselves,” Speak to their qualities, Share the time commitment involved in position, activity, Write a quick note “thanks for listening to me.”
